Road accidents: Taking charge

- 1** Road accidents often draw a crowd of curious onlookers. Ask who is willing to help and give them simple tasks to do, such as warning incoming traffic, taking care of victims with light injuries, or shielding distressed victims from view.



- 2** Victims who are fully conscious and who are able to walk should be helped to a safer area. When they arrive, emergency services will then be able to administer aid to the more seriously injured without the intervention of distressed relatives or friends.



- 3** When calling emergency services, stay calm and speak clearly. Answer all questions as best as you can. Do not hang up until the operator has cleared the line.
